## **Empowering Learning Analytics – Moving Toward the Future with a Transparent Data Culture**

2–3 November 2026 · FernUniversität in Hagen · on site

Hosted by CATALPA and LEAD:FUH, in collaboration with Hochschulforum Digitalisierung (HFD) and Stiftung Innovation in der Hochschullehre (STiL).

How do we move learning analytics (LA) from research papers into everyday teaching and learning? On 2 and 3 November 2026, CATALPA and LEAD:FUH bring together researchers, instructors, and higher education management to jointly foster a sustainable and transparent data culture in LA. The programme combines practical workshops, an application-focused poster and demo session, keynotes, and interactive formats that connect research, practice, and innovation.

We invite poster or demo contributions that show LA in action: from prototypes being prepared for pilot studies to large-scale implementations already running in real teaching contexts. Submissions with initial evaluation results are particularly welcome.

Best submissions will be brought on the stage for a short presentation and all accepted contributions will be presented on a poster walk on day 1 (2 November) with Q&A and informal discussion during the evening reception.

### **TOPICS OF INTEREST**

Contributions are welcome on, but not limited to:

#### **1. Student-facing LA systems**

- Feedback and reflection support
- Recommender systems
- Dashboards
- Self-regulated learning (SRL) support tools
- Generative-AI-based feedback or tutoring
- Early-warning and at-risk indicators delivered to students
- Nudges and interventions

#### **2. Teacher-facing LA systems**

- Learning design support and iterative-improvement analytics

- Early-warning and at-risk dashboards
- Programme- or curriculum-level analytics
- Collaboration and group analytics

### 3. Design support

- Indicator archives and databases
- Methods, templates, or canvases for participatory LA design
- Tools for ethics, trust, and responsibility in LA design

### 4. Infrastructures for LA

- Learning Record Stores, xAPI/Caliper pipelines, and data interoperability
- Data governance, consent, and privacy infrastructure
- Institutional rollout and scaling architectures

- Length: 2–4 pages, including references.
- Language: English or German
