The *E-Teaching Certificate – Focus: International* allows teachers to acquire skills in digitally supported, international teaching.

The program supports teachers at the FernUniversität to plan and implement international teaching/learning formats in distance learning.

- Implement a teaching project together with international partners, such as a summer/winter school, excursion or seminar
- Expand your intercultural skills and make valuable international contacts

- Compulsory consultation before project start (ZLI and IO)
- Implementation with international partners (support in finding international partners provided by IO if necessary)
- Collegial job shadowing

Elective subject (at least 24 WU)
